Graduate Student Admission Criteria

1. Applicants who have already completed the requirements for a bachelor's degree and who are seeking a second bachelor's degree and/or teacher certification must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75, take the writing exam and speech and hearing screening, pass the CIL exam, pass the Special Education Math Test, and meet the ACT/academic requirements.
2. Matriculated graduate students must have a GPA of 2.75 on their last 20 semester hours of academic work, pass the CIL exam, and complete the speech and hearing screening.
